

**REVIEW OF ANNUAL ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT
HARYANA PWD (B&R) DEPARTMENT FOR THE YEAR 2014-15**

The Public Works Department (Building and Roads) is the principal department of the State Government for the construction and maintenance of roads, bridges and government buildings in the state of Haryana. It has set up statewide offices to accomplish the task of construction and maintenance of roads, bridges and government buildings. It enjoys a strong reputation for engineering capabilities and quality manpower. It has also set up the Haryana State Roads and Bridges Development Corporation Ltd. (HSRDC) Haryana Rural Roads and Infrastructure Development Agency (HARRIDA); Haryana State Buildings & Roads Academy of Research and Trainings at Hisar to achieve its objectives

Building and Road infrastructure have been one of the major thrust areas of the State Government right from the beginning. On November 1,1966, when the State of Haryana was carved out from the joint Punjab, it launched a massive drive to connect each and every village with a population of 250 and achieved this target by 31 March,1973. The length of road network increased to 13,322 kms by 31 March,1973. Now the road length is as under:

FUNCTIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS

During the year 2014-15, the Public Works Department (Buildings and Roads) carried out its normal activities for the construction and maintenance of Buildings, Roads and Bridges.

1. DEVELOPMENT OF STATE ROADS IN HARYANA DURING 2014-15

Since the formation of Haryana on November 01,1966, there has been all-round development in the State especially in the recognized field of construction of roads to link directory and non-directory villages. Out of 6764 directory villages, as per 2001 census, only 1386 villages were connected as on November 01,1966 with the existence of 5100 km. road length. The village connectivity has been enhanced to 6759 Km and the metalled length has gone upto 26001 km. It has increased by 5.30 times as on 31, March, 2015.

2. ANNUAL PLAN TARGETS AND ACHIEVEMENTS

Annual Plan 2014-15 was originally approved for Rs. 1623.15 crore which was finally revised to Rs 1828.15 crore out of which Rs. 411.08 crore was provided for 5054 No. of roads only.

38 Kms. Of new roads were constructed during 2014-15 under head 5054 (R&B).

872 km of roads has been improved under head 5054 (R&B) by way of widening, strengthening, raising, Reconstruction, Premix Carpet and C.C. Blocks etc during the year 2014-15.

3. MAINTENANCE OF ROADS DURING 2014-15

Length of roads in Haryana including National Highways as on 31.3.2015 is 26001 Kms. whose detail is given as under:-

Rs. 521.34 crore were provided for repair and maintenance of roads. Widening/ strengthening/ raising/ Reconstruction/ Premix Carpet was carried out on 2732 km. of roads during 2014-15 besides carrying out patch work and other special repair of roads.

Although repair is a continuous activity, yet a lot has been done to restore confidence among the people. Moreover, during 2014-15, there was a total ban on mining activities in Haryana. In spite of this fact, the road network was kept in satisfactory level of service through carrying out extensive patch work campaigns by the department.

4. WORKS UNDER PPP SCHEME

To bridge gap in investment in infrastructures, the Govt. of Haryana took initiative to carry out works on PPP mode.

First road project of Haryana on Build, Operate and Transfer (BOT) basis for improvement of Gurgaon-Faridabad & Ballabgarh-Sohna roads was awarded to M/s Reliance Infrastructure Ltd. on negative grant of Rs. 150.30 crores. Work has been completed and the concessionaire has been collecting toll since June 2012 and concession period is seventeen (17) years for this project.

5. **NATIONAL HIGHWAY**

Out of the total length of 2126 km, 21 National Highways passing through the Haryana State. 12 National Highways with a total length of 842 km also are entrusted to Public Works (B&R) Department for improvement and maintenance. The remaining 9 National Highways (NH-1,NH-2,NH-8, NH -10, NH -22, NH-71,NH-71-A, NH-73 & NH-65), are with National Highways Authority of India (NHAI).

The department has incurred an expenditure of Rs. 61.84 crore against the allocation of Rs. 43.00 crore under “Original Works Head”, Rs.19.79 crore against the allocation of Rs. 6.99 crore under “Periodical Repairs Head” and Rs. 1.58 crore against the allocations of Rs. 1.71 crore under “ Normal Maintenance & Flood Damages Restoration Head”. During this year, the activities under taken were as under:-

a) **Widening to 4- lanes**

A Length of 7.45 km costing Rs. 40.44 crore was under progress during year 2014-15. An expenditure of Rs. 22.76 crore were incurred during year 2014-2015 and work on 4.45 Km. completed.

b) **Strengthening /IRQ**

Strengthening of 82.69 km costing Rs. 141.30 crore were under progress during the year 2014-15 on NH 71-B, 72 & 73 A, extension 709, 248-A, 334B, 703 & 11 . The work on 2.63 km with cost of Rs. 17.51 crore were completed during year 2014-15.

c) **Miscellaneous Works.**

In addition to the above, 18 miscellaneous works such as construction and repair of bridges, repair of railing of ROB's etc. were also taken up during the year. An expenditure of Rs. 19.98 crore has been incurred on these works during year 2014-15. 10 miscellaneous works costing Rs. 17.22 crore have been completed during year 2014-15.

6. **CENTRAL ROAD FUND**

Main CRF

- a) 7 roads having length of 90.16 km with estimated cost of Rs. 132.28 crore during year 2014-15 were in progress. An expenditure of Rs. 78.69 crore were incurred on these works.
- b) During 2014-15 one work of length 18.25 Km was completed with an expenditure of Rs. 54.43 Crores.

Interstate Connectivity Important Roads

- c) One work with length of 2.87 km with estimated cost of Rs. 5.94 crore during year 2014-15 was in progress.

7. **Prime Minister Gramin sadak Yojna**

a) **PMGSY Phase-1 to IX**

Pradhan Mantri Gramin Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) was launched by Govt. of India, through Ministry of Rural Development (MORD) on December 25, 2000. PMGSY is a totally Centrally sponsored scheme. This programme has now been altered, expanded and renamed as Bharat Nirman. PMGSY is a sub section of Bharat Nirman.

b) **PMGSY Phase-II**

83 Roads and 18 Bridges work of PMGSY-II were allotted in the year 2014-15. Rs.244.27 Crores have been released by MoRTH and Rs 81.42 crores by State Govt. Against total receipt of Rs 325.69 crores expenditure done during 2014-15 is Rs 365-25 Crores. Physical progress during the year 2014-15 is 629.95 Km. There is no pending PMGSY-I works (Phase I to IX). All works stand completed.

8. **NABARD PROJECT**

a) **NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF – XIII (Roads)**

All the projects under RIDF-XIII have been completed.

b) **NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDE RIDF-XIII (Bridges)**

All the 13 works have been completed. The total expenditure incurred during the year 2014-15 is Rs. 0.02 Crores.

c) **NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDE-XIV (Roads)**

All the 15 No. works have been completed. The total expenditure incurred during the year 2014-15 is Rs. 0.36 Crores.

d) ***NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF-XIV (Bridges)***

All the 4 works have been completed.

e) ***NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF-XV (Roads)***

All the 14 works have been completed. The total expenditure incurred during the year 2014-15 is Rs. 1.70 Crore.

f) ***NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF-XVI (Bridges)***

All the 14 Bridges have been completed. The total expenditure incurred during the year 2014-15 is Rs. 6.67 crore.

g) ***NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF-XVI (Roads)***

All the 13 No. works have been completed. The total expenditure incurred during the year 2014-15 is Rs. 0.38 crore.

h) ***NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF-XVIII (Roads)***

Out of 25 No. works 20 works have been completed. The total expenditure incurred during the year 2014-15 is Rs. 37.73 cr. About 281.18 Km. length out of 322.93 Km. has been completed.

i) ***NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF-XIX (Roads)***

32 nos. roads for amounting to Rs. 376.57 crore having length of 264.13 km have been approved from the Nabard. Out of 32 no. works 12 works have been completed . The total expenditure incurred during the year 2014-15 is Rs. 103.48 Crore. About 97.75 km length out of 264.13 km length has been completed.

j) ***NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF-XIX (Bridge)***

22 nos. bridges amounting to Rs. 100.63 Crore have been approved from NABARD. Out of 22 no. works 20 no. works have been allotted and 2 no. works have been dropped. The total expenditure incurred during the year 2014-15 is Rs. 22.01 Crore.

k) ***NABARD PROJECT UNDER RIDF-XX (Roads)***

31 nos. Road amounting to Rs. 353.60 Crore having length of 246.09 km have been approved by Nabard.

12 bridges under Head 5054 with an approximate cost of Rs. 30.74 crore have been completed during year 2014-15, 5 Nos. Bridges with an approximate cost of Rs. 28.27 crores in Progress under Head 5054 during the year 2014-15, 4 Nos. ROBs/RUBs with the cost of Rs. 97.97 crore were completed and 13 Nos. ROBs/RUBs in Progress under Head 5054 with an estimated cost of Rs. 482.67 crore, 5 Nos. ROBs/RUBs in Progress under Deposit Head with an estimated cost of Rs. 53.98 Crore.

During the year, 117 buildings and 97 houses were completed. The total expenditure incurred on Construction and maintenance of all type of buildings in State was to the tune of Rs. 83277.53 Crore through PWD (B&R).

Mahesh Kumar remained in the capacity of Engineer-in-Chief, Managing Director, HSRDC and Secretary General, (HARRIDA) during the year 2014-2015.

ADMINISTRATIVE SETUP

The administrative & professional Head of the Deptt. is Engineer-in-Chief. There are seven Chief Engineers i.e. (i) Chief Engineer (Buildings), (ii) Chief Engineer (Roads), (iii) Chief Engineer (National Highways), (iv) Chief Engineer (Nabard), (v) Chief Engineer (Bridges) and (vi) Chief Engineer (NCR) (vii) Chief Engineer (Elect.& Mech.). Chief Engineers are responsible for their works to Engineer-in-Chief and Govt. There are 11- Civil Circles, one Mechanical and one Electrical Circle. Each Circle is headed by Superintending Engineer, generally consisting of three to four Divisions. There are 46 Civil Divisions, 5 Electrical Divisions & 5 Mechanical Divisions. Divisions are headed by Executive Engineers consisting of three to four Sub Divisions. Sub Divisions consist of three to four Sections headed by Junior Engineers in charge of Sections.

There is a well developed Mechanical wing headed by a Superintending Engineer (Mechanical) who reports to the Engineer-in-Chief through the Chief Engineer (E&M). The State has large fleet of machinery and it is maintained in the Central Mechanical Workshop at Karnal; besides a chain of regional workshops. There is an Electrical wing headed by SE (Electrical) who looks after the electrical works of the Buildings and reports to Chief Engineer (E&M).

The work of Horticulture wing is controlled by one Executive Engineers (Hort.) who is assisted by Sub-Divisional Engineers. The work of acquiring the land for buildings and roads is looked after by Land Acquisition Officers.

The State Research Laboratory is situated at Hisar and is headed by a Chief Engineer, designated as Director Research Laboratory. There is a Quality Control cell headed by Dy. Director at Hisar and Executive Engineers (Quality Control) located at Faridabad & Karnal, who examine the quality of materials and perform tests, independent of the construction agency. Apart from the main Research Laboratory at Hisar, there are regional laboratories at Bhiwani, Rohtak and Karnal besides the field laboratories working at sites of major construction works. During the year, 2938 no. samples were taken by Quality Control Cell, out of which 2902 were passed and 36 no are under re-checking.

Haryana State Roads & Bridges Development Corporation is headed by Managing Director-cum-Engineer-in-Chief and assisted by Executive Director who is Chief Engineer on deputation from the Department and there are 7 no. DGMs located in field in the rank of Executive Engineers, are also on deputation from PWD (B&R) Deptt. Whereas, Haryana Rural Roads and Infrastructure Development Agency (HARRIDA) is headed by Secretary General- cum-Engineer-in-Chief PWD (B&R) and assisted by Executive Director who is Chief Engineer (Nabard) and various PIUs in the rank of Executive Engineers posted in the field.

EXPENDITURE ON WORKS AND ESTABLISHMENT

An expenditure of Rs 2739.1 crore was incurred on various works of Roads, Bridges and Buildings, both in respect of Construction and maintenance. The break up as under:-
